HireRight Widescreen Plus supplements HireRight's criminal search products by enabling organizations to conduct a wider search for an applicant's potential criminal history.

Introduction

Widescreen Plus supplements several of HireRight's criminal and offense history search products by providing a source of 'tips and leads' information that can help reveal difficult to locate criminal records. Numerous, diverse, and unique sources are checked to help uncover an applicant's criminal history in jurisdictions beyond those in the applicant's known address history. All potential records found by HireRight Widescreen Plus are confirmed for currency, accuracy and completeness at the source before they are reported. HireRight Widescreen Plus sources includes data aggregated from county courts, state sex offender registries, state Administrative Offices of Courts, Departments of Correction, Departments of Public Safety and the Federal Office of Foreign Asset Control (OFAC) as well as HireRight's unique data containing results compiled from more than 30 years of background checks. Widescreen Plus includes a combined 1400 sources and supports coverage in over 70% of the US population; more than 650 million records from all levels of government; SOR registries with sources from 50 states plus Washington DC, Guam, Puerto Rico, US Virgin Islands, and select tribal territories; and 130+ Prohibited Parties sources (Sanctions, Exclusions, and Watch Lists).

Process

HireRight requires an applicant's name, date of birth, and Social Security Number (SSN) to perform a HireRight Widescreen Plus search and then to confirm the record with other HireRight searches, if needed. To ensure that any records found are accurate, current, and complete – and to comply with Fair Credit Reporting Act (FCRA) requirements – HireRight automatically performs all confirmation record searches at the applicable primary source(s).

Examples of these additional sources may include records compiled from:

- The Office of Foreign Assets Control (OFAC)
- Office of Inspector General (OIG)
- Politically Exposed Person List
- Department of Public Safety (DPS)
- Violent Offender Registry (VOR)
- Securities and Exchange Commission (SEC)
- Financial Sanctions
- System for Award Management (SAM) Excluded Parties List

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Results

The databases searched by HireRight Widescreen Plus generally contain records of criminal cases and sex or violent offender registries. Any records found by HireRight Widescreen Plus are verified with the original source of the record. Only records that are validated by the original source are reported.

Considerations

HireRight Widescreen Plus does not include records from counties or states where the necessary databases are not available. Moreover, existing databases are updated on different schedules and some do not include all offense records, registries, or other entries. It is also possible for previous records to be removed during updates. The databases searched reflect the best database information available at the time of search, but they should not be considered comprehensive or complete. Therefore, HireRight Widescreen Plus should not be the sole or primary source used for searching for a candidate's criminal history or current registry as a sex offender, presence on an OFAC list, or any other data set included as part of the Widescreen Plus search.
